Our laws need to respect the rights of people with disability.

You should be included in community life.

**You have the same rights as everyone.**



What are your **rights**?



You have the right to:

- privacy and confidentiality
- be treated with dignity and respect
- a safe and healthy environment in your home and anywhere else



You should be able to:

- be part of your cultural community
- participate in your religion
- express your sexuality
- communicate in your family's language



You should be able to:

- make complaints and have them dealt with fairly and promptly
- to say you want to go to another provider



You are entitled to understand all the information provided to you so that you can make informed choices regarding:

- your services and supports (what you want and when you want it)
- your carer (what type of worker you want)
- how you want things done



We will always follow your instructions, unless we feel that you may get hurt then we will talk to you or your trusted person about the risk.



We agree to follow your wishes and the Charter of Rights.
